The Birdville ISD Scholarship ensures tuition costs of up to a maximum of 15 credit hours per semester, to each student who meets all eligibility criteria. This scholarship is available for two consecutive semesters, not including summer.

## **Birdville ISD Scholarship Criteria**

- Graduating seniors must have attended Birdville ISD schools for both junior and senior years. Students graduating early must have earned their credits for their junior and senior year at a BISD school.
- ◆ Applicants must complete the admissions process for TCC, which includes:
  - Submitting an admissions application
  - Submitting official high school transcript(s)
  - Completing testing requirements
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application and list TCC as one of the institutions to which enrollment is sought to determine eligibility.
- Students must have completed the entire FAFSA process by the semester deadline.
  - Fall Semester July 1
  - Spring Semester January 1
- ◆ Students must enroll at TCC and complete a minimum of six semester hours per semester.
- Students must enroll at TCC during the first fall or spring semester immediately following graduation (except in cases of deferment due to active U.S. military service). TCC must be the first college of attendance.
- Students must enroll and successfully complete STSC 0111 (Transition to College Success) their first semester at TCC. Students that are exempt or have met the TSI obligations are not required to complete STSC 0111.
- Students will be required to meet with their academic advisor before dropping any course(s).
- Students will be required to meet with their academic advisor a minimum of three times during the course of each semester.
- Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 to be eligible for renewal.
